During the "IAF IDEA 3G Diversity Afternoon" that took place on Wednesday 3 October at the International Astronautical Congress 2018 in Bremen, Germany, WIA-E had the honour to present a sponsored event, which included an update on network activities and an award ceremony.

IDEA, an International platform for **D**iversity and **E**quality in **A**ustronautics that focuses on the three G's – Geography, Generation and Gender, provided the framework for our presentation of WIA-E updates, including mentoring programmes, awards, grants, training workshops, local networking opportunities and much more. An awards committee of space professionals evaluates and decides on the winners based on the quality of the essay.

Key Note Speech: "Can space help us imagine a more equitable world?"

Welcome by Annamaria Nassisi, Director of WIA-E Communication; **Keynote Speech: Danielle Wood,** assistant professor of Media Arts and Sciences at the MIT Media Lab

Dr. Wood leads the Space Enabled Research Group seeking to advance justice in earth's complex systems using designs enabled by space. Dr. Wood is a scholar of societal development with a background that includes satellite design, earth science applications, systems engineering, and technology policy for the US and emerging nations. In her research, Dr. Wood designs innovative systems that harness space technology addressing development challenges worldwide. Wood's research also develops systems analysis tools improving decision making during complex systems design. Most recently, Dr. Wood worked as the Applied Sciences Manager within the Earth Science Division of Goddard Space Flight Center.

Welcome: Antonella Sgambati, WIA-E Bremen Local Group Leader; **Keynote Speech: Helia Sharif**, WIA-E member

Helia holds a B. A. Sc. in Systems Engineering from Simon Fraser University and a M. A. Sc. in Aerospace Engineering from Carleton University in Canada. Additionally, she has completed the Space Studies Program at the International Space University in Austria. Her passion for space and robotics has lead her to pursue a number of exciting and unique opportunities ranging from camping in the Arctic while working for NASA, to developing image processing algorithm at the Advanced Concepts Team in the European Space Agency, and for Canadian Space Agency's micro-rover: Kapvik. She pursued a doctoral thesis research degree funded by the German Aerospace Center (DLR) to train satellites become smarter. She's responsible for the design of an autonomous vision-based system on board aerial vehicles to help in guidance and navigation manoeuvres in real-time.


