# 01. INTRODUCTION

In 2016, Women in Aerospace Europe celebrated its 7<sup>th</sup> anniversary. The association has grown fast since it was founded in 2009. 


#### 3.1 INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS


#### MEMBERS PER NATIONALITY

#### 4.1 INTERNATIONAL EVENTS

#### WIA-Europe breakfast at Space Innovation Congress - April 8, 2016

The Space Innovation Congress is the showcase event for space related technology which took place in London, 7th - 8th April 2016. Before Day 2 of Space Innovation Congress starts, Women in Aerospace Europe hosted its traditional Networking Breakfast with the theme 'Diversity in Science'. The event was opened by WIA-Europe's Executive Director Elena Feichtinger who introduced the moderator, Paola Belingheri, WIA-E Director of Individual Membership. The first part of the WIA-E Breakfast started with a welcome from our Honorary President Simonetta di Pippo (Director of United



Nations Office for Outer Space Affairs). Following on, Kiyoshi Higuchi, President of the International Astronautical Federation, Francisco Javier Mendieta Jimenez, Director of the General Mexican Space Agency and Pascale Ehrenfreund, Chair of the Executive Board German Aerospace Center warmly welcomed the participants and addressed the importance of the work that we are doing at WIA-Europe. The following section included important and representative speakers such as Jan Wörner, Director General of the European Space Agency and Simonetta di Pippo, Director of UNOOSA and

Honorary President of WIA-E, that addressed specific initiatives within the institutional environment and also Kay Sears, Vice President of Strategy and Business Development of Lockheed Martin that presented her personal experience and illustrated some initiatives coming from the industrial environment, where Gender Diversity plays an important role. The participants highly appreciated the informal atmosphere and opportunities to have time and space to talk to each other, to get to know new contacts and to have the chance to chat with the attending Board Members from WIA-Europe in order to ask questions, propose initiatives and bridge network gaps.

# WIA-Europe Panel at IAC -September 28, 2016

The WIA-E Panel about "Space: new paths towards a balanced and inclusive development" was attended by more than 120 participants. The panelists highlighted original issues in



relation to a balanced and inclusive development of the aerospace field.

# WIA-Europe lunch at the XXIA ASE Planetary Congres - October 4, 2016

On October  $4^{\rm th}$ , corporate member Thales Alenia Space (TAS) sponsored the WIA-E lunch on at the XXIA ASE Planetary Congress, University of technology in Vienna, Austria, held from 3-7 October 2016. The moderator of the event was Barbara Imhof, WIA-E.



Keynote speakers were Simonetta di Pippo, Director United Nations Office for Outer Space Affairs; Annamaria Nassisi, Manager Market Intelligence, Thales Alenia Space and Astronauts Sandy Magnus, US; Claudie Haigneré, Europe; Chiaki Mukai, Japan; Julie

Payette, Canada. Main astronaut voices from the US, Canada, Europe and Japan talked about the importance of getting more women involved in the aerospace sector and about delivering sustainable support into top positions.

WIA-Europe Breakfast at the UN/UAE High Level Forum - November 21, 2016 UNOOSA, the United Arab Emirates (UAE) Agency and the Mohammed Bin Rashid Space Centre, were great supporters of the WIA-E sponsored breakfast event, held in Dubai on 21 November 2016 with the following speakers: Simonetta Di Pippo, United Nations Office for Outer Space Affairs; Sumaya Al Hajeri, United Arab Emirates Space Agency; Khuloud Al Harmoodi, Mohammed Bin Rashid Space Centre; Gale Allen, National Aeronautics and Space Administration and Dominique Tilmans, Eurisy. This first High Level Forum in Dubai forms one of the milestones on the way to develop a UNISPACE+50 declaration in 2018 in Vienna, two further High Level Fora are expected on the way towards 2018. This year marks at the same time the anniversary of the UNISPACE I Conference as the first worldwide conference in the UN frame dealing with Space in 1968. More than 40 participants - be it male or female - followed the speeches and had afterwards very lively discussions. Simonetta Di Pippo previewed a UNOOSA project called "Space for Women" aimed at showing how space-based technology can contribute towards achieving gender equality, one of the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

### Launch of Local Group UK - October 27, 2016

The WIA-E UK local group was successfully launched at the Reinventing Space Conference in London. Over 40 aerospace professionals enjoyed croissants and coffee in the Royal Society's Marble Hall whilst listening to the inspiring words of guest speaker Dr. Alice Bunn, Policy Director at the UK Space Agency. Afterwards two lucky raffle winners were presented with copies of the book How to Thrive and Survive as a Working Woman, written by Fiona Elsa Dent and Viki Holton. The breakfast, sponsored by the Satellite Applications Catapult and Airbus Defence and Space, gave participants the chance to talk with the committee and share their vision for WIA-E UK.




